APRIL 2017 CAUSE OF THE MONTH: LIFE ElderCare

Life Elder Care is a service that focuses on the elderly who are isolated, vulnerable, disabled and at risk. Programs include: **Meals on Wheels:** Provides meals delivered M-F to seniors' homes & frozen meals for the weekend. **VIP Rides:** Provides rides to doctor's appointments and the grocery store that includes other assistance as needed. **Friendly Visitors:** Matches frail, isolated seniors with volunteers that provide companionship through weekly visits, phone calls and outings. **Fall Prevention:** Provides a strength and balancing routine, an at-home safety check, minor home modifications, and a medication review for possible drug interactions. **Lavender Seniors:** Provides social support services and a vibrant caring community of LGBTQ older adults.
