Life Elder Care is a service that focuses on the elderly who are isolated, vulnerable, disabled and at risk. Programs include: Meals on Wheels: Provides meals delivered M-F to seniors' homes & frozen meals for the weekend. VIP Rides: Provides rides to doctor's appointments and the grocery store that includes other assistance as needed. Friendly Visitors: Matches frail, isolated seniors with volunteers that provide companionship through weekly visits, phone calls and outings. Fall Prevention: Provides a strength and balancing routine, an at-home safety check, minor home modifications, and a medication review for possible drug interactions. Lavender Seniors: Provides social support services and a vibrant caring community of LGBTQ older adults.
