### Earn each time you stock your pantry:

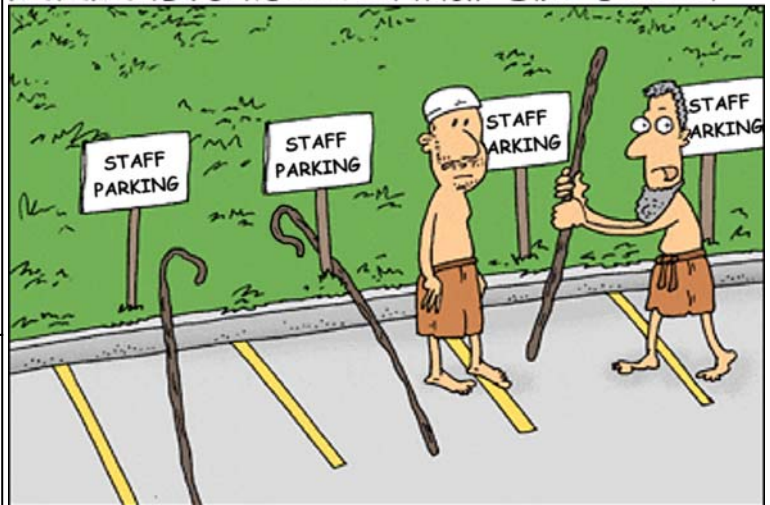

\$100/wk.	\$104	\$156	\$208
\$150/wk.	\$156	\$234	\$312
\$200/wk.	\$208	\$312	\$416
