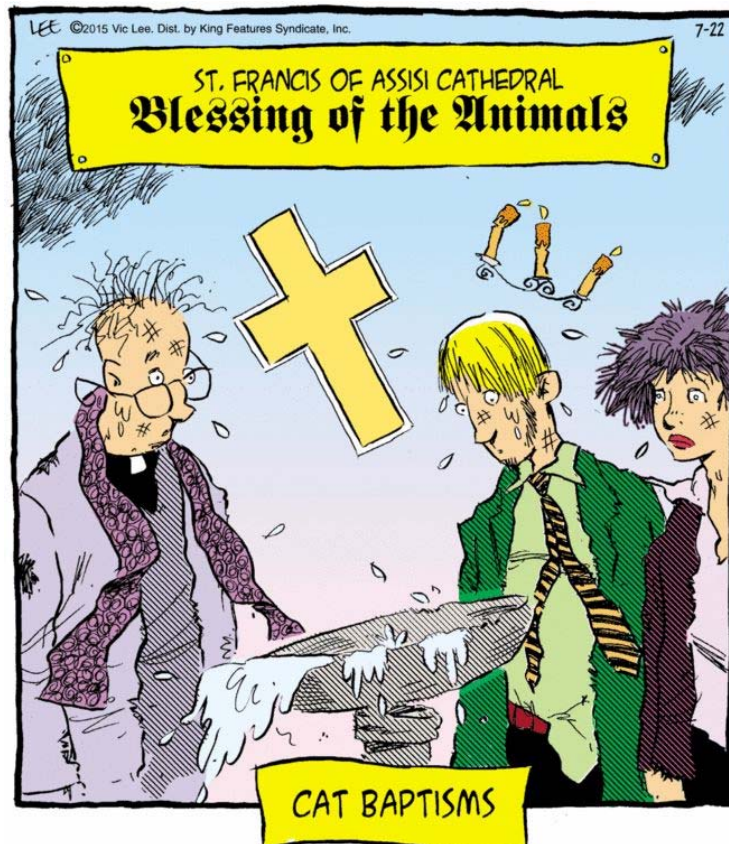

REFORMATION 500 FUN FACTS

Prior to the Reformation, congregational singing during church services wasn't standard practice in Germany. Martin Luther is quoted as saying, "Next to the Word of God, the noble art of music is the greatest treasure in the world." Luther composed more than 40 hymns in his lifetime, and in 1529 wrote and composed the tune for what became known as "The Battle Hymn of the Reformation"—today called "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God."
