What is ScripNow®?

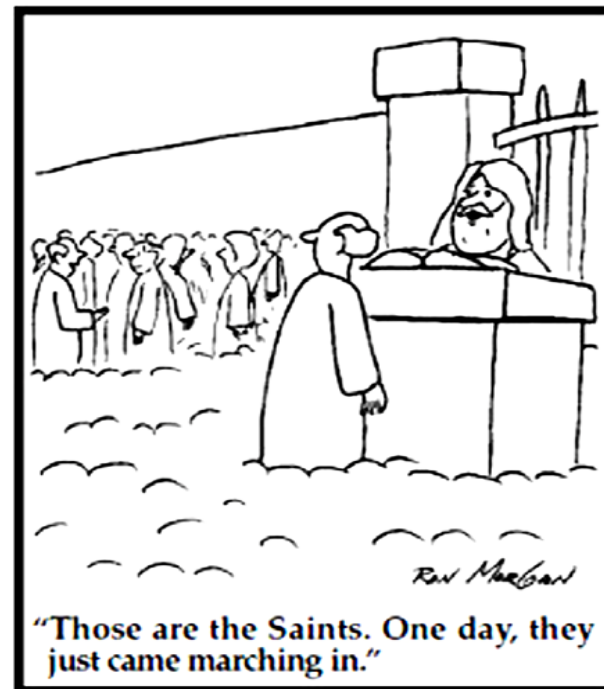

The ScripNow eCard is delivered to your ShopWithScrip account in minutes when you pay for your order with PrestoPay - 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Print the certificate and redeem it in stores, or show the clerk the bar code directly from your phone, or copy and paste the code at

checkout to apply to an online purchase. You'll receive an email confirmation when your ScripNow is ready. Or you can refresh the ScripNow tab on your Wallet page until you see your newly delivered eCard at the top of the list.
