Vern Van Dusen Memorial: \$715.00

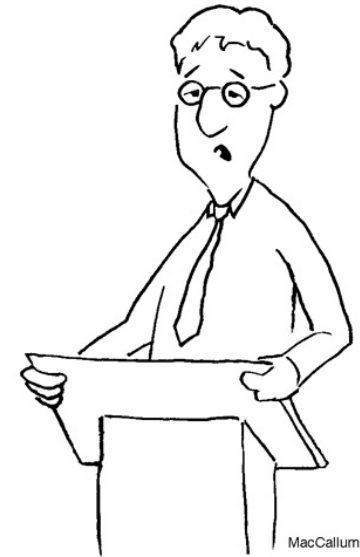
