December.

We took in:
 \$56,552.53 in General Offerings
 \$1,816.00 in Designated Giving
 \$12,010.00 on Christmas Eve
 For a December total of \$70,378.53 (That is not a typo)

We closed out the fiscal year with a surplus of \$6,238.13

Expenses for December were \$20,656.61 (Budgeted and Designated)

Use Scrip for fuel purchases:

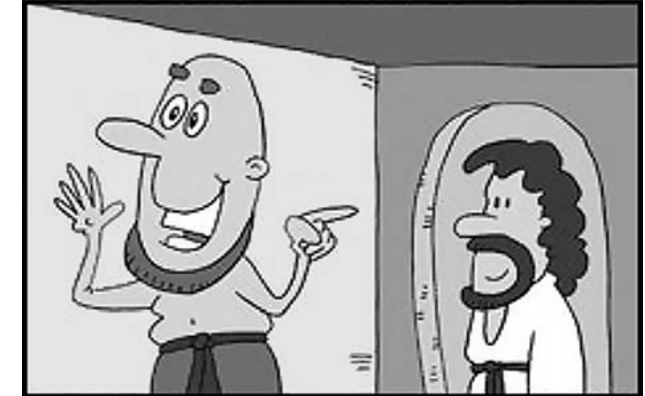

Our scrip program offers gift cards from many major gas retailers, and many of our gas brands are available in Reload! This means that with select brands you can add funds to gift cards you've already purchased and have them available by the next day when you pay with PrestoPay™. See how much you

can earn per year when you're fueling up:

Gas Spending	2% Rebate	3% Rebate	4% Rebate
\$200/mo.	\$48	\$72	\$96
\$300/mo.	\$72	\$108	\$144
\$400/mo.	\$96	\$144	\$192
