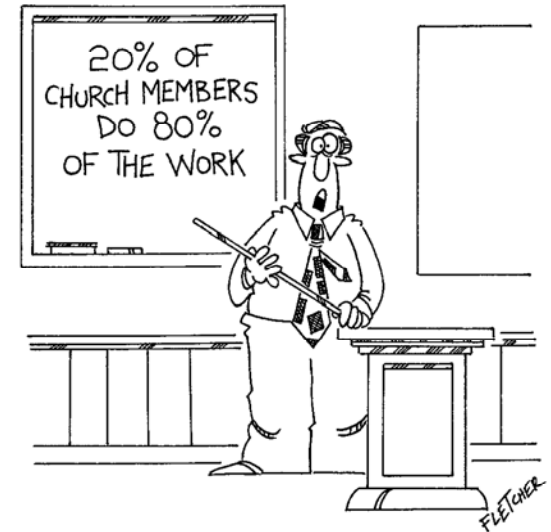
Scrip Tip

Earn each time you stock your pantry:

You spend a big portion of your monthly budget on groceries for your family. But did you know there's a way to make all that money work for you? By using scrip to pay for your regular grocery purchases, you can earn funds for our organization every time you shop. You pay face value and your gift card is worth face value, but our organization earns a rebate on every gift card you purchase. See how much you can earn per year:

Grocery Spending	2% Rebate	3% Rebate	4% Rebate
\$100/wk.	\$104	\$156	\$208
\$150/wk.	\$156	\$234	\$312
\$200/wk.	\$208	\$312	\$416

Imagine if 10, 20, 30 or more people were using scrip to pay for their groceries!

CAUSE OF THE MONTH

February 2018: The Center for Gender and Refugee Studies

The Center for Gender & Refugee Studies protects the fundamental human rights of women, children, LGBT individuals, and other refugees who flee persecution. CGRS tracks and monitors the outcome of gender asylum cases nationwide at all levels of immigration adjudication in order to assist attorneys in individual cases as well as to identify decision-making trends that inform their advocacy efforts, maintaining an asylum database housing unpublished briefs and decisions available nowhere else. Additionally, CGRS is working on several coordinated fronts to address the needs of unaccompanied immigrant and refugee children arriving at our border.
