February 2018: The Center for Gender and Refugee Studies

The Center for Gender & Refugee Studies protects the fundamental human rights of women, children, LGBT individuals, and other refugees who flee persecution. CGRS tracks and monitors the outcome of gender asylum cases nationwide at all levels of immigration adjudication in order to assist attorneys in individual cases as well as to identify decision-making trends that inform their advocacy efforts, maintaining an asylum database housing unpublished briefs and decisions available nowhere else. Additionally, CGRS is working on several coordinated fronts to address the needs of unaccompanied immigrant and refugee children arriving at our border.
