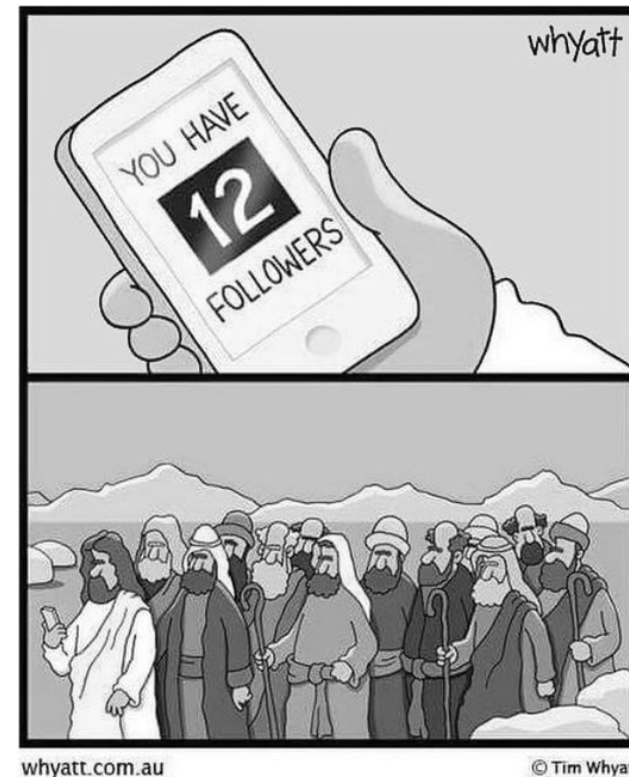
### Spaghetti Feed Donations
