End of February: shortfall of <\$3,548.42>

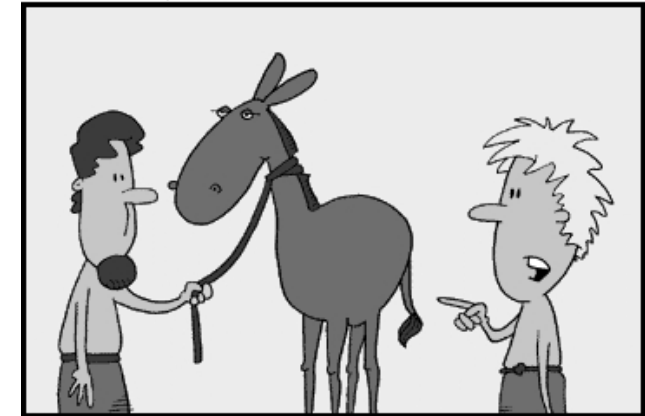
