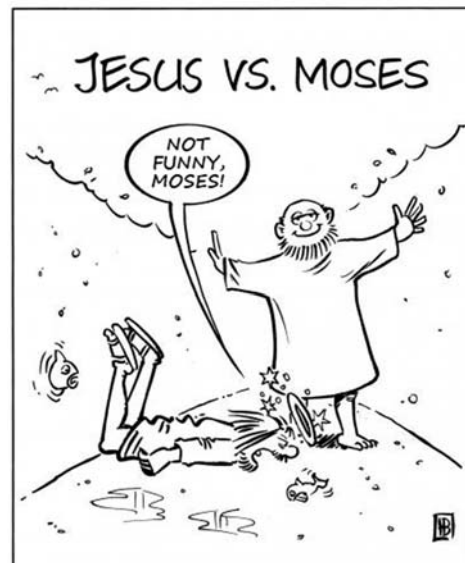

Abode Services provides housing and other services (including tutoring and counseling for low-income students) to more than 6,100 people each year across Alameda and other nearby counties. These kids need the same supplies our kids need: pencils, markers and crayons, paper, binders, and notebooks. A \$50 donation buys them nearly everything they need to start the year. We'll collect monetary donations through the end of August. Additionally, we'll collect supplies for them in a box in the narthex through mid-August to help them get ready for school, which starts before Labor Day. 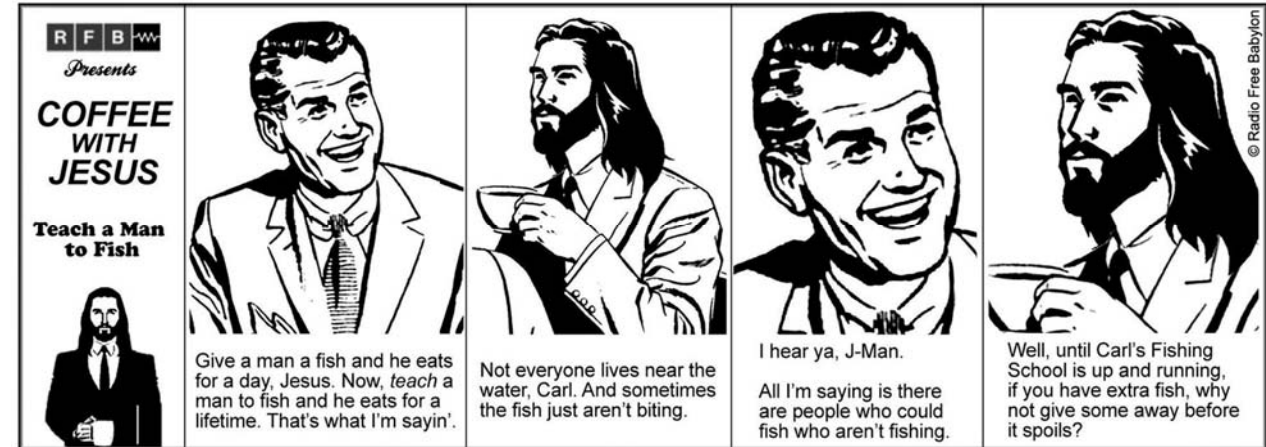
### HTLC Day at the Ballpark
