Scrip Tip

What is ScripNow®?

Electronic gift cards are available from many of our retailers, and can be ordered and printed from your ShopWithScrip® account or used directly from your smart phone. The ScripNow eCard is delivered to your ShopWithScrip account in minutes when you pay for your order with PrestoPay - 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Print the certificate and redeem it in stores, or show the clerk the bar code directly from your phone, or copy and

paste the code at checkout to apply to an online purchase. You'll receive an email confirmation when your ScripNow is ready. Or you can refresh the ScripNow tab on your Wallet page until you see your newly delivered eCard at the top of the list.

We use a singing during quiet times in our worship services. Singing bowls produce sounds which invoke a deep state of relaxation which naturally assists one in entering into prayer and meditation. Tibetan singing bowls are also used for stress reduction and healing. Our Tibetan bowl is over 100 years old.

August 2018: School Supplies for Children in Abode Services

Please consider helping schoolchildren whose families receive services from Abode in Fremont. Abode Services provides housing and other services (including tutoring and counseling for children) to more than 6,100 people each year across Alameda and other nearby counties. These kids need the same supplies our kids need: pencils, markers, crayons, paper, binders, notebooks, and backpacks. A \$50 donation provides nearly everything they need to start the year.
