Actual Income: \$15,419.56

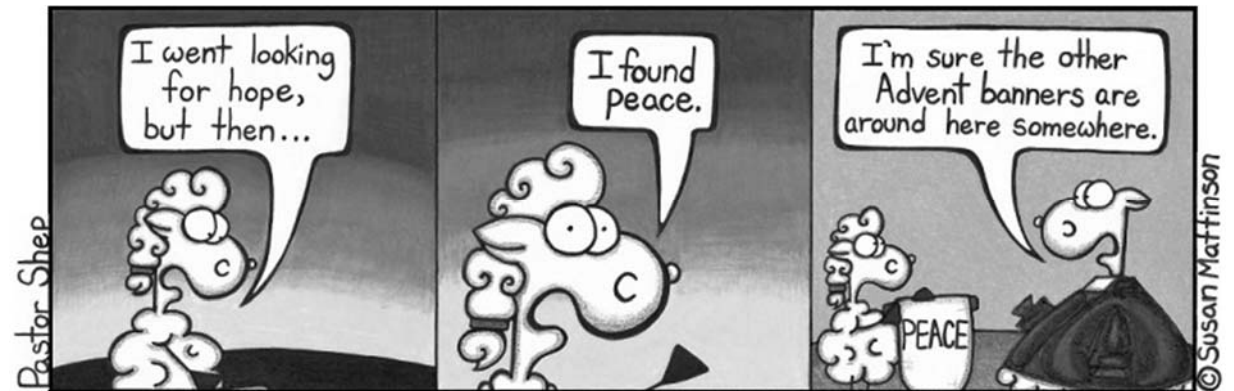
Budgeted Expenses \$19,325.00
