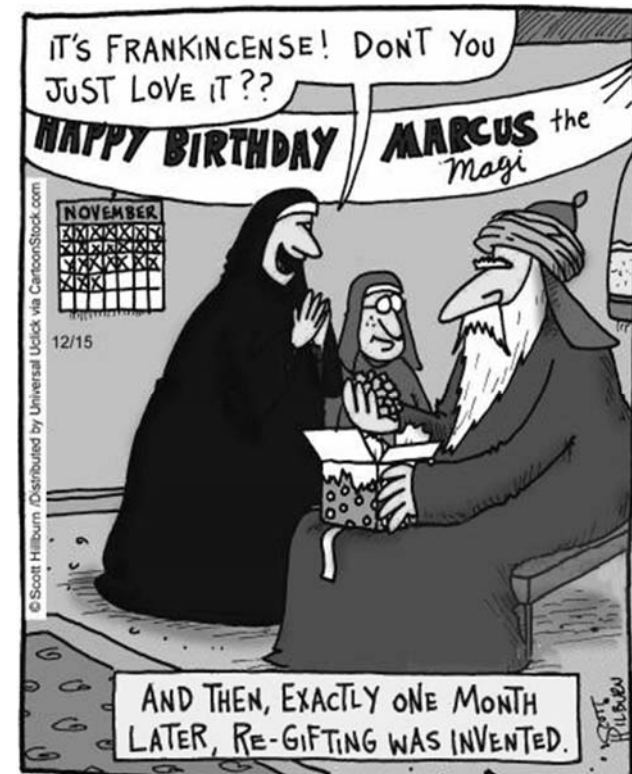
### Tuesday Bible Study
