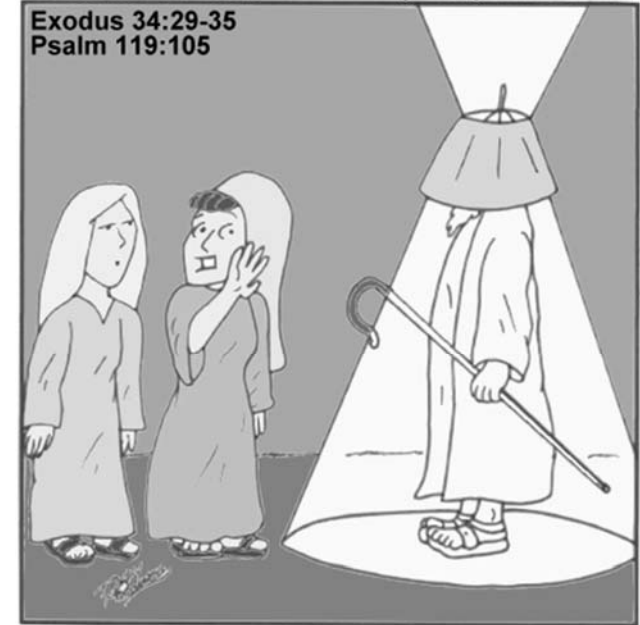
### Stewardship 2019 Update
