You pay face value and your gift card is worth face value, but our organization earns a rebate on every gift card you purchase. See how much you can earn per year:

Grocery Spending	2% Rebate	3% Rebate	4% Rebate
\$100/wk.	\$104	\$156	\$208
\$150/wk.	\$156	\$234	\$312
\$200/wk.	\$208	\$312	\$416

Imagine if 10 people were using scrip to pay for their groceries! How about 20, 30, or more?
