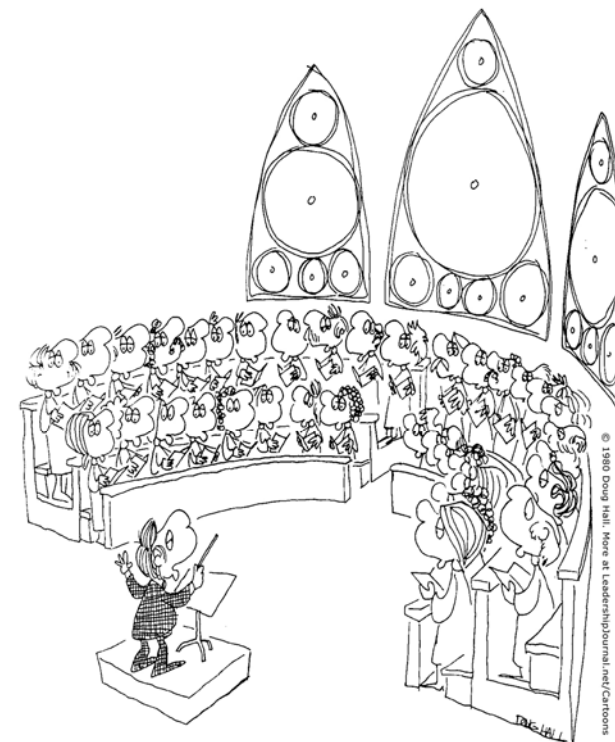


Stewardship Spotlight
