A ShopWithScrip® account is the easiest way to place an order. Go to [www.ShopWithScrip.com](http://www.ShopWithScrip.com) and click on the 'Register' button at the top of the page. Next, click 'Join a Scrip Program.' You will need to enter your organization's unique enrollment code, B768EC1D14576, to link your account activity with our

organization. Next, fill in all the required information and click 'Register.' You will be asked to select two challenge questions and provide answers, which will be required if you forget your password.
