

threat.


All: **We return to you in this place today to be reminded that

CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS

All may make the sign of the cross,
the sign marked at baptism.

P: God of faithful love and powerful purpose, there are times when we are open to your leading— times when we walk the path of Jesus with courage and hope, even when doing so is fearful.

All: At other times, we close ourselves off, hoping that you won't tear open the skies and disrupt our lives completely.

P: Following Jesus can be pretty risky.

All: Your compassion and faithful love claim us forever,

P: as they claimed Jesus when he entered the Jordan and made a bold decision to follow you

All: on a new and uncertain path. Amen.

Silence is kept for reflection

P: God's compassion and love are forever!

All: What God said of Jesus at his baptism, God says to us today:

P: You are my dearly loved children, whom I love deeply.

All: God forgives us and loves us dearly, now and forevermore.

GREETING

P: Blessed be the holy Trinity, one God, the fountain of living water, the rock who gave us birth, our light and our salvation.

All: Amen.



LENTEN LITANY

L: Almighty God, be with us as we contend with our lives and all our challenges.

All: Thank you for listening as we bring before you the troubles that undermine us.

L: We affirm, it is written, "One does not live by bread alone."

All: Strengthen and sustain our families and our communities.

L: Nurture the bonds between us and inspire us to live with empathy and forgiveness.

All: Help those struggling with work or facing uncertainty in their futures, that they may find peace in your abundant love.

L: Jesus, our Redeemer, rescue us when we stumble.

All: Enable us to admit the temptations of the world, and support us to resist turning away from your teaching.

L: Awaken us to recognize the gifts you have given each one of us, and to see the role we can play in healing your creation.

All: God, our Creator, inspire us with renewed hope.

L: Deepen our faith to hear your word and follow your way.

All: Encourage us to bring all our hopes and desires to you in prayer,

L: that in lifting up our souls to you,

All: we may be shaped by your love.
