



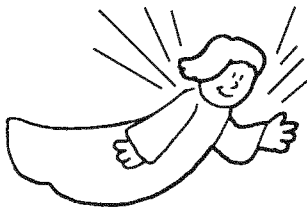

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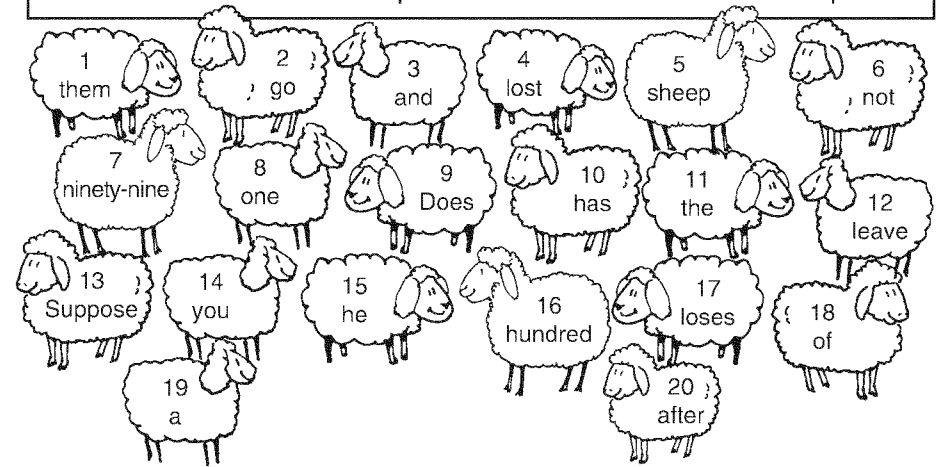


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The Lost Sheep and the Lost Coin

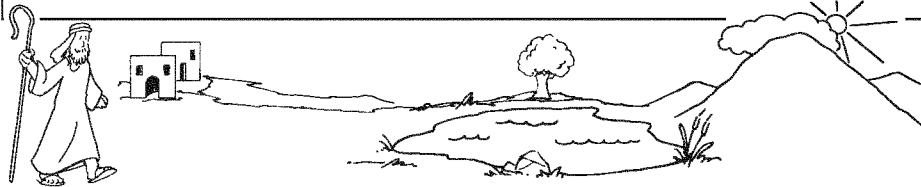
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What did Jesus say would happen when the shepherd finds the lost sheep?
