L: You call us to pray with our hands, our mouths, and our feet. You are calling us to create a just world for all of your children.

L: You have given us all that we need fight for a better, safer tomorrow for children and families of all races, religions, and socio-economic status.

All: This, we believe.

L: Let us worship a God who creates and cares and loves.

All: Let us worship on this Children's Sabbath Day

CALL TO CONFESSION

All may make the sign of the cross, the sign marked at baptism.

P: O God, we confess that too often our hearts are hardened to the struggles of others, including children in poverty; our hearts are narrowed in the circle of those we love, excluding children not our "own" our hearts are discouraged and too ready to give up on things that matter, like ending poverty.

All: We confess that too often our voices are silent in the face of injustice, our voices are soft in the presence of the powerful, our voices talk over those whom we want to help.

- P: Forgive us, O God. Soften our hearts to love as you do, broaden our embrace to include others, and instill in us hope so that we do not lose heart.
- All: Stir us, we pray, to call out injustice, strengthen our voices to speak up for change, and sensitize us to hear those unheard.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

- P: Hear the good news! Jesus came so that we would know that there is nothing that can make God stop loving us. In Jesus Christ we are forgiven.

READING – 2 *Timothy 3:14--4:5*


You, for your part, must remain faithful to what you have learned and believed, because you know who your teachers were. Likewise, from your infancy you have known the sacred scriptures, the source of wisdom which through faith in Christ Jesus leads to salvation. All scripture is inspired of God, and is useful for teaching—for reprimanding, correcting, and training in justice—so that the people of God may be fully competent and equipped for every good work.

In the presence of God and of Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead, and in view of the appearance and reign of Christ, I charge you to preach the word; to be prepared in season and out of season; to correct, reprimand and encourage with great patience and careful instruction. For the time is coming when people won't put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers who say what their fickle ears want to hear. They will turn their ears away from truth and turn aside to myths. But you, keep your head in all situations; endure hardship, perform your work as an evangelist and fulfill your ministry.



L: Source of Comfort, we pray for those who have died, especially those who died too young, too soon, from causes we could have prevented. We pray for those whose lives were lost to disease and despair, to brutality and bullying, to shootings and to suicide. Help us to be your arms of care for those who grieve and your voice to prevent unnecessary losses. Source of Comfort, we pray:

WORDS OF INSTITUTION

- P: We give you thanks and praise, amazing God, who made heaven and earth and sea, and all that is in them, who keeps faith forever, who executes justice for the oppressed, who gives food to the hungry; You watch over the strangers, uphold the children and most vulnerable, and have triumphed over sin and evil.
- All: On this Children's Sabbath day, we give you thanks, O God, especially for children, for the blessing they are and the blessing we may be to them, as we seek to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with you.
- P: We praise you, O God, for sending your beloved child Jesus born as a baby, nurtured by his family, who grew as a child who was taught in his temple, surrounded by his community, and guided by his parents, who became an adult who loved and blessed the children, who cared for those who were sick, poor, and left out, who taught that God loves us like a parent, and who called us his friends.
- All: This one who was born a baby needing us died our Savior whom we all need, triumphant even over death, freeing us to live as your beloved children.
- P: On the night before he died for us, Jesus was at the table with his friends. He took bread, gave thanks, broke it, and gave it to them, and said: "Take, eat: This is my Body, which is given for you. As you do this, remember me." As supper was ending, Jesus took the cup of wine. Again, he gave thanks, gave it to them, and said: "Drink this, all of you: This is my Blood of the new Covenant, which is poured out for you and for all for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, remember me." Around your table, as your children, O God, we remember Jesus Christ, who came in love, lived in love, and died in love, who was and is and is to come.
- All: We offer to you our gifts of bread and wine and we offer to you our lives.

- P: Pour out your Spirit upon these gifts that they may be for us the body and blood of Christ, that they strengthen us to welcome the children, to show your love, to work for your justice.
- All: Through Christ and with Christ and in Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, to you be honor, glory, and praise, for ever and ever.

THE LORD'S PRAYER

- P: Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us, using the language or translation of our hearts.
- All: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Save us from the time of trial and deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and forever. Amen.

FRACTION RITE

P: This is the bread that comes down from heaven and gives life to all the world's children.


All: Whoever eats this bread will live forever. Amen.

Holy Communion is open to all. Grape juice is white, wine is red.

Gluten-free Wafers are available upon request. Let an Usher know if you desire Communion brought to you.

For walking communion:

You may come down the center aisle. Hold out your hand for the pastor to drop the wafer into, then take a cup of wine (red) or grape juice (white) from the assistant's tray, then return to your seat via the side aisles, depositing your disposable cup in the provided bowls.

For communion at your seat with pre-packaged kit:

You may come down the center aisle, take a communion kit from the assistant, and return to your seat to partake, or you may remain seated and partake of the communion kit you picked up at the entrance. The ushers will come around to collect empty kits.
