Reader: The first reading is from Acts, chapter two,

READING: Acts 2:14a, 22-32

Then Peter stood up with the Eleven and addressed the crowd: "People of Israel, hear this: Jesus of Nazareth was sent to you with miracles, portents and signs as his credentials—which God performed through him in your midst, as you well know. Jesus was delivered up by the set purpose and plan of God; you even made use of godless people to crucify and kill him. God freed him from death's bitter pangs, however, and raised him up again, for it was impossible that death could keep its hold on him. David says,

'I have set our God ever before me; God is at my right hand, and I will not be disturbed. My heart has been glad, my tongue has rejoiced, my body will live on in hope, for you will not abandon my soul to Hades, nor will you let your faithful one undergo decay. You have shown me the paths of Life; you will fill me with joy in your presence.' "Sisters and brothers, I can speak confidently to you about our ancestor David. He died and was buried, and his grave is with us to this day. But he was a prophet, and he knew that God had promised him with an oath that one of his descendants would sit upon his throne. So what he was foreseeing and talking about was the resurrection of the Messiah: the one not abandoned to the underworld, whose body didn't decay. God raised Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses to that.

GOSPEL: Matthew 28:1-10

After the Sabbath, as the first day of the week was dawning, Mary of Magdala came with Mary to inspect the tomb.

Suddenly, there was a severe earthquake, and an angel of God descended from heaven, rolled back the stone, and sat on it. The angel's appearance was like lightning, with garments white as snow. The guards shook with fear and fell down as though they were dead.

Then the angel spoke, addressing the women: "Don't be afraid. I know you are looking for Jesus the crucified, who is no longer here. Jesus has been raised, exactly as it was foretold. Come and see the burial place. Then go quickly and tell the disciples that Jesus has risen from the dead and now goes ahead of you to Galilee. You will see Jesus there. That is the message I have for you."

The women hurried away from the tomb with awe and great joy and ran to carry the good news to the disciples.

Suddenly Jesus stood before them and said, "Shalom!" The women came up, embraced Jesus' feet and worshiped. At this, Jesus said to them, "Don't be afraid! Go tell the disciples to go to Galilee, where they will see me."

Again, after supper, he took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it up for all to drink, saying: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this for the remembrance of me."

With thanksgiving, we take this bread and this cup and proclaim the mystery of faith.

All: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.

P: Pour out your Holy Spirit upon us that this meal may be a communion in the body and blood of our Lord.

All: Make us one with Christ and with all who share this feast.

P: Unite us in faith, encourage us with hope, inspire us to love,

Let an usher know if you need communion brought to you.

For walking communion:

You may come down the center aisle. Hold out your hand for the pastor to drop the wafer into, then take a cup of wine (red) or grape juice (white) from the assistant's tray, then return to your seat via the side aisles, depositing your disposable cup in the provided bowls.

For communion at your seat with pre-packaged kit:

You may come down the center aisle, take a communion kit from the assistant, and return to your seat to partake, or you may remain seated and partake of the communion kit you picked up at the entrance. The ushers will come around to collect empty kits.
