

## INTRODUCTION TO THE WORD

R: Risen Christ, may the words we speak and the stories we hear

All: invite us into a deeper relationship with you and with one another. Amen.

R: The first reading is from First John, chapter three, beginning with the sixteenth verse.

#### **READING:** 1 John 3:16-24

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ died for us. And we, too, ought to lay down our lives for our sisters and brothers. If you have more than enough material possessions and see your neighbors in need yet close your hearts to them, how can the love of God be living in you?

My children, our love must not be simply words or mere talk—it must be true love, which shows itself in action and truth. This, then, is how we'll know we belong to the truth; this is how we'll be confident in God's presence, even if our consciences condemn us. We know that God is greater than our consciences and that God knows everything. And if our consciences do not condemn us, my friends, then we have confidence before God, and we will receive whatever we ask from God's hand—because we keep the commandments and do what is pleasing in God's sight.

The commandments are these: that we believe in the name of God's Own, Jesus Christ, and that we love one another as we were told to do. Those who keep these commandments live in God and God lives in them. We know that God lives in us by the Spirit given to us.

R: The Holy One is with us this day,

All: offering us God's love and light.

R: The risen Christ is among us,

All: inviting us to share what we have seen and heard.

R: The Holy Spirit guides our way,

All: teaching us to take care of our neighbors,


R: and making sure that all are welcomed and loved.

#### **GOSPEL:** John 10:11-18

I am the good shepherd. A good shepherd would die for the sheep. The hired hand, who is neither shepherd nor owner of the sheep, catches sight of the wolf coming and runs away, leaving the sheep to be scattered or snatched by the wolf. That's because the hired hand works only for pay and has no concern for the sheep.

I am the good shepherd. I know my sheep and my sheep know me, in the same way Abba God knows me and I know God—and for these sheep I will lay down my life. I have other sheep that don't belong to this fold—I must lead them too, and they will hear my voice.

And then there will be one flock, one shepherd. This is why Abba God loves me—because I lay down my life, only to take it up again. No one takes my life from me; I lay it down freely. I have the power to lay it down, and I have the power to take it up again. This command I received from my Abba."

# PRESENTATION OF VOTING AND ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

P: Dear friends, we give thanks for the gift of baptism and for Janice, Jay, and Sharon - one with us in the body of Christ, whom we welcome as new members into the life and ministry of this congregation.

In baptism, we are welcomed into the body of Christ and sent to share in the mission of God. We are called to live among God's faithful people, to hear the word of God and share in the Lord's Supper, to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed, to serve all people, following the example of Jesus, and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth.

As you desire to make public affirmation as a sign of your renewal and participation in the life and work of the Church of Christ, we ask you the following questions:

All: Keep us close together in your Spirit, in the breaking of bread, the prayers, and in service to others.

All: We come to share God's blessings with the world.



# THE GREAT THANKSGIVING

L: God is with you.

All: And also with you.

L: Open up your hearts.

All: We open them to our Creator.

L: Let us give thanks and celebrate.

All: It is good to do so.

P: Like the two disciples on the road to Emmaus, we walk with Jesus, but do not recognize him. Yet Jesus persists, opening our hearts to truth and love as we share table with him.

As he gathers us close, Jesus takes the bread, blesses it, and breaks it, and we eat together: you, me, and

Christ at the table. In the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks; broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying: "Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me."

Again, after supper, he took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it for all to drink, saying: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people. It is during the meal that we recognize Christ, see the gift of God's love, and are transformed. Only then can we truly say, "The Lord has risen!" for Christ is risen in our hearts. Friends, loved ones, this table is prepared by Christ for the transformation and redemption of the world.

All: At this table, we recognize Christ and God's love rises in our hearts. Come, let us break bread with the One who is present now.

#### THE LORD'S PRAYER

P: Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us, using the language or translation of our hearts.



Wine is red, grape juice is yellow, water is in the center of the tray. Gluten-free wafers are available upon request.


Let an usher know if you need communion brought to you.


#### For communion at the altar rail:

Rise and return to your seat via the side aisles.


