- R: A reading from Second Corinthians, chapter three, beginning with the twelfth verse.


READING: 2 Corinthians 3:12–4:2

With such hope we are very bold in what we say. And we are not like Moses, who covered his face with a veil to keep the Israelites from gazing at the radiance as it faded away. But their minds had been dulled, and to this day the same veil remains whenever the old Covenant is read—it has not been taken away, for only in Christ can it be removed. To this day, whenever Moses is read, a veil covers their understanding.


But whenever anyone turns to our God, the veil is removed. Now our God is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of our God is, there is freedom. And we, who with unveiled faces reflect our God's glory, grow brighter and brighter as we are being transformed into the image we reflect. This is the work of our God, who is Spirit. RESPONSE TO THE WORD


- R: God, you come and do not keep silent, no matter the strength of the wind or the intensity of the fire.

GOSPEL: Luke 9:28-36

Now about eight days after these sayings Jesus took with him Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. And while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white. Suddenly they saw two men, Moses and Elijah, talking to him. They appeared in glory and were speaking of his departure, which he was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. Now Peter and his companions were weighed down with sleep; but since they had stayed awake, they saw his glory and the two men who stood with him. Just as they were leaving him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah"not knowing what he said. While he was saying this, a cloud came and overshadowed them; and they were terrified as they entered the cloud. Then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!" When the voice had spoken. Jesus was found alone. And they kept silent and in those days told no one any of the things they had seen.

- P: It is right and a good and joyful thing, always and everywhere, to give thanks to you, Almighty God, creator of heaven and earth. From ancient times, you brought forth light from primordial darkness, created us in your image,
- All: called us to be your people, and shone through us with your love.
- *P:* When we wandered in darkness and became lost in grumbling and fear,
- All: you led us as a pillar of light and beckoned us home.
- *P:* In the words of prophets and poets, you called us to return to your light,
- All: offering us a vision of renewal and promising us a better future.
- *P:* And in the fullness of time, you sent your Son, Christ Jesus, the Light of the World, to redeem us with love and grace, invite us to walk in the light, and shine as light for the world.

And so, with your people on earth, and all the company of heaven, we praise your name and join their unending hymn:

- All: Holy God of endless love, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Blessed is the One who was born that we might have life. Glory to God and on earth peace to all people.
- P: Holy are you, and blessed is your child of light, Christ Jesus. With humble gratitude, we remember the night when the darkness of impending death began closing in. Jesus took the bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to disciples, who had witnessed the glory of his transfiguration and who would soon witness his death, saying: "Take, eat, this is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

After supper, Jesus took the cup, blessed it and gave it to his disciples, saying: "Drink from this, all of you. This is my life, poured out for you and for many, for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often as your drink it, in remembrance of me."

And so, in remembrance of these, your mighty acts of love and light, we offer ourselves in praise and thanksgiving. As your covenant people and as reflections of your glory, in union with Christ's love for us, we proclaim the mystery of faith.

All: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.

- *P:* Pour out your Holy Spirit on us and on these gifts of bread and wine.
- All: May these be for us your life and love, shining through us with the power of your Holy Spirit.
- P: Through these gifts, may all be one with you, one with each other, and one in the ministry of love and light to the world, until Christ comes in final victory and we feast at your heavenly banquet. Through Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit in your holy Church, all honor and glory is yours, Almighty God, now and forevermore.

THE LORD'S PRAYER


- *P:* Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us, using the language or translation of our hearts.

Wine is red, grape juice is yellow, water is in the center of the tray. Gluten-free wafers are available upon request. Let an usher know if you need communion brought to you.




For communion at the altar rail:

When directed by the ushers, you may come up the center aisle to the altar rail, stand or kneel, and hold out your hand for the pastor to drop the host into. Eat. Then take a cup of wine (red), grape juice (light yellow), or water (clear) from the assistant. Drink. Then place your empty cup in the tray that follows. Rise and return to your seat via the side aisles.

- All: Strengthen us for service, and send us out to embody your good news of liberation and healing for the sake of the world. In the name of Christ we pray, Amen.




